"Brief Trip Summary"

Day 1 - Saturday May 13 - We will meet at our Hotel in downtown Chicago. Those who need rental motorcycles will need to pick them up in the afternoon. We will help with the rental process. We would like everyone to check-in to the hotel prior to 6:00 PM and be ready for the group welcome dinner at 7:00 PM. It will give everyone a chance to meet and get acquainted with those we will be riding with for the next two weeks. There will be a presentation on the ride and we will also have a safety presentation so we all understand how we will be riding together.

Day 2 - Sunday May 14 - We will leave the hotel at 9:00 AM and leave for the starting point of Route 66 for photos and to kick-off our ride. Leaving Chicago and its suburbs is an experience in itself. We will ride and stop at many Route 66 landmarks throughout the day before we stop for the evening in Springfield, Illinois approximately 230 miles later.

Day 3- Monday May 15- A great day of riding from Springfield, IL to St. Louis. This is an easy day's ride of 165 miles. It will be a busy day because of all the sites we will stop and see.

Day 4 - Tuesday May 16 - St. Louis to Springfield Missouri - 215 miles Great day of riding as we continue west into the Ozark Mountains of Missouri

Day 5 - Wednesday May 17 - Springfield Missouri to Tulsa, Ok - 220 miles - We ride from Missouri into Kansas for 13 miles before heading into Oklahoma

Day 6 - Thursday May 18 - Tulsa, Ok to Clinton Ok - 200 miles a great day of riding through rural Oklahoma with stops in some quaint small towns for a home cooked meal and some Route 66 history.

Day 7 - Friday May 19 - Clinton Ok - Amarillo, Tx 185 miles - We will have our mid-tour group dinner in Amarillo at a "famous" Texas steak house. It will be the perfect ending of a great day's riding and sight seeing.

Day 8 - Saturday May 20 - Amarillo to Albuquerque, NM 300 miles - This is a long and interesting riding day. We leave the agricultural area of the Texas panhandle and ride through the desert of New Mexico. There will be some very interesting sights today including the Cadillac Ranch

Day 9 - Sunday May 21 - Albuquerque to Cortez, Colorado 275 miles - Today we take a side trip to the 4 Corners Monument. It is the only place in the US you can be in 4 states at one time. (Utah, Colorado, New Mexico and Arizona)

Day 10- Monday May 22 - Cortez to Flagstaff, Az. - 325 miles We will get back on RT 66 where we left it and continue our way west. We will ride through the Petrified Forest, Painted Desert, and stop at the "Corner" in Winslow Az. before we get to Flagstaff.

Day 11 - Tuesday May 23 - Flagstaff - Grand Canyon - Flagstaff 200 miles - Today we ride to the Grand Canyon. Be ready to see one of the natural wonders of the world and one of the most amazing places on earth. Today is one continuous photo opportunity so be prepared.

Day 12 - Wednesday May 24 Flagstaff to Needles, Ca - 210 Miles - We will ride the longest undisturbed length of the RT 66. From Ash Fork to Topock, Az before we reach Needles, Ca.

Day 13 - Thursday May 25 - Needles to Barstow Ca - 160 miles - We will ride the National Old Trails Highway and stop at The Mother Road Museum. It will be a hot day so we will not ride as long as we have been riding in prior days

Day 14 - Friday May 26 - Barstow to Los Angeles 130 Miles We arrive in Los Angeles and will have a departure dinner for everyone to complete our tour of Historic Route 66. We will return rental motorcycles prior to checking into our hotel.

Day 15 - Saturday May 27 - Depart for Home.
